#### Years 5 & 6

In Year 5 we have really enjoyed reading 'Street Child' in and we will be using this to write a scene for a play over the next few weeks. In PSHE we have been learning about self-esteem and how to look after our own well-being. We have also been practising a range of stitches in DT in preparation for making a tote bag.



It has been an incredibly busy few weeks in Year 6 and we are so proud of the effort put in by all children last week when it was the SATs. Well done to everyone for your amazing attitudes! We have also started a new Science topic of 'Animals including Humans' and so far this has included learning what blood is composed of, making a 'blood smoothie' and also learning how the heart works to pump blood around our bodies to collect oxygen from the lungs and deliver it to our vital organs.
