- Compare how I am now to when I was a baby and explain how I have changed

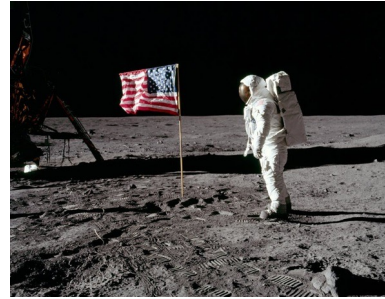
In Music we will focus on:
