In maths, we will:

- Understand what percentages are and how they are calculated.
- Solve problems involving the conversion of fractions, decimals and percentages.
- Convert between different units of metric measure, including km and m, cm and m, cm and mm, g and kg and I and ml.
- Use all four operations to solve problems involving measure

As Scientists we will discover:

- The gestation periods of different mammals and how they compare to humans.
- Stages of foetal development and the growth and development of humans as they develop to old age
- The differences in lifecycles of insects, mammals, amphibians and birds.

In PSHE we will focus on 'Changing Me' and relationships, learning to:

- Know how I can develop my own self-esteem.
- Explain how a girl's / boy's body changes during puberty.
- Understand that belonging to an online community can have positive and negative consequences.

In Music we will focus on:

- · Listening, appreciating and performing
- Learning songs and rehearsing ready for our end of year production in July.

As Geographers we will develop an understanding of:

- The climate at the North and South Poles.
- Volcanoes, including how and why they occur and where they are found.
- Why the ring of Fire is so special.
- Why and where earthquakes happen.

As Historians we will explore the questions:

- What was the Industrial Revolution and when did it take place?
- How did people in Britain live before the Industrial Revolution?
- Who was George Stephenson and what was his contribution to the Industrial Revolution?

- What does a pilgrim do on their pilgrimage?
- What might they take/leave?
- What does pilgrimage mean to a believer?
- What might be the lasting impact on their life?

English

Reading

Street Child by Berlie Doherty and The Nowhere Emporium by Ross Mackenzie will be the focus texts in our reading lessons. We will:

- Clarify the meaning of words in context
- Retrieve information
- Make inferences about characters and use evidence to support this

Writing

Street Child will also be the focus text in our writing lessons. We will be applying skills to our writing, including a narrative set in Victorian England, a newspaper report and a fantasy story.

In PE, we will:

- Develop skills in athletics, including throwing and jumping.
- Refine our knowledge and skills in team games through playing rounders and cricket.

As Artists and Designers we will:

- Use the work of Hokusai as inspiration for our own sketches, including using different lines, shapes and colours to create effects and represent movement of the waves.
- Design and make a bag using sewing techniques.

In Computing we will be focusing on programming. We will learn how to:

- Design and program a character game.
- Make player in a game move to the second level.
