<u>Maths</u>

Place Value including:

- Counting in 100s, 10s and 1s
- Number line to 1000
- Find 1, 10 and 100 less
- Compare and order objects and numbers
- Count in 50s

Addition and Subtraction including:

- Add and subtract 3 digit and 1 digit numbers
- Add and subtract 3 digit and 2 digit numbers

As Scientists we will:

- Know that dark is the absence of light
- Know that light is needed in order to see and is reflected from a surface
- Demonstrate how a shadow is formed and explain how a shadow changes shape

In PSHE we will focus on 'Being Me in my World', learning to:

- Explain how my behaviour can affect how others feel and behave
- Explain why it is important to have rules and how that helps me and others in my class learn
- Feel (and make others feel) valued

In Music we will focus on:

- Performing
- Listening
- Appreciating
