## Year 5 - Autumn

### As Geographers, we will:

- Use a range of maps, atlases, digital online mapping and data retrieval (e.g. google earth) locate countries and capitals in Scandinavia
- Locate countries and cities of the United Kingdom (linked to Viking landings on the East coast) identifying human and physical characteristics

**In PE, we will learn skills in Dance (indoor) and skills to apply to the game of Hockey (outdoor).**

### As Historians, we will explore the questions:

- Where did the Vikings come from?
- When did the Vikings invade Britain?
- What impact did the Viking invasion have on people living in Britain at the time?
- What was Danegeld?

**In Latin, we will explain the origins of the English language and learn new Latin words and their meaning.**

## English

### Reading

Beowulf and Grendel by Michael Morpurgo will be the focus text in our reading lessons. We will:

- Clarify the meaning of words in context
- Retrieve information
- Make inferences about characters and use evidence to support this
- Identify themes across a wide range of books

### Writing

Beowulf and Grendel (Michael Morpurgo) will also be the focus text in our writing lessons.

We will be applying skills to write:

- A legend based on the story of Beowulf
- A recount (diary)

### As Artists and Designers, we will:

- Study Van Gogh: Starry Night
- Create a painting inspired by this image using a range of painting techniques

**In Computing, we will be focusing on online safety to answer these questions:**

- Should I share digital content?
- What is appropriate online and how do I stay safe?
- Is all content online reliable?

**In RE and World Views, we will focus on the topic 'Expressions of Faith' including:**
