<u>Maths</u>

<u>Place Value including:</u>

- Rounding to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000
- Compare and order any numbers
- Numbers to a million
- Negative numbers

Four Operations including:

- Add and subtract numbers with more than 4-digits
- Multiply 4-digit by a 2-digit number
- Short and long division

As Scientists we will:

- Compare and give reasons for why components work and do not work in a circuit
- Draw circuit diagrams using correct symbols
- Know how the number and voltage of cells in a circuit links to the brightness of a lamp

In PSHE we will focus on 'Being Me in my World', learning to:

- Explain how my choices can have an impact on people in my immediate community and globally.
- Empathise with others in my community and globally and explain how this can influence the choices I make.

In Music we will focus on:

- Listening
- Appreciating
- History of music

<u>Year 6 – Autumn</u> Our topic for the Autumn Term is: **World War Two**



As Geographers we will:

- Use a range of maps, atlases, digital online mapping and data retrieval (e.g. google earth) to locate countries and capitals worldwide
- Study time zones
- Reach informed conclusions using terrestrial, aerial and satellite photographs

In PE, we will learn skills in Dance (indoor) and skills to apply to the game of Hockey (outdoor).

As Historians we will explore the questions:

- What was happening in Britain in 1940?
- What events led up to the Battle of Britain?
- How serious was the risk of invasion by Germany in 1940?
- What did Hitler need to achieve if an invasion was going to succeed?

In R.E. and World Views we will focus on the topic 'Justice and Freedom' including:

- What would the world be like without forgiveness?
- Comparing different views about religion.

<u>English</u> Reading

The Boy in the Striped Pyjamas by John Boyne will be the focus text in our reading lessons. We will:

- Clarify the meaning of words in context
- Retrieve information
- Make inferences about characters and use evidence to support this
- Identify themes across a wide range of books

<u>Writing</u>

Rose Blanche will be the focus text in our writing lessons.

We will be applying skills to write:

- A narrative that raises a dilemma
- A newspaper report (recount)

In Latin, we will explain the origins of the English language and learn new Latin words and their meaning.

As Artists and Designers we will:

- Focus on drawing and sketching using charcoal and pastels to create different effects.
- Learn how to programme and create a nightlight using the crumble kits.

In Computing we will be focusing on online safety to answer these questions:

- What are the risks/ benefits of mobile devices broadcasting the location of the user?
- How does your digital footprint impact upon yourself and others in the long-term?
- What are the positive and negative influences on of technology on health and environment?
