Dear Parents and Carers,

A few reminders:

- Please ensure all pupils have their full P.E. kit for both indoor and outdoor P.E. – white T-shirt, navy/black shorts, dark plain tracksuit bottoms/leggings and sweatshirt/hoodie (no bright colours or sports kits please).
- Sandshoes are part of our school uniform and **must** be worn in the school. Please ensure your child has black sandshoes to change into in order to keep their classroom environment clean and tidy.
- Jewellery must not be worn in school for safety reasons. Children can wear a watch and a pair of stud earrings, although these must be taped over or removed for PE. Children should not wear make up or nail varnish, including false nails.
- Reading at home needs to be completed at least three times a week. Please sign your child's reading record as evidence of the reading taking place and send into school each Thursday so that your child can earn their Leading Learner sticker for the week.
- Year 6 homework will be weekly, sent out on a Thursday and due back in school the following Tuesday.
- If your child needs to bring their phone to school, they must hand it in to a member of staff when they arrive at school. Please ensure that you have read and signed the consent form for the mobile phone policy.
