Maths

Place Value including:

- Numbers to a million
- Rounding to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000
- Compare and order numbers to a million

Four Operations including:

- Add and subtract numbers with more than 4-digits
- Use rounding, estimating and the inverse to check calculations
- Look at multiples, factors, prime and square numbers
- Multiply and divide by powers of 10, 100, 1000

English

Reading

Our focus reading text this half term will be 'Beowulf and Grendel, the Monster of the Night' by Michael Morpurgo.

We will:

- Clarify the meaning of words in context
- Provide reasoned justification for views
- Make predictions, based on details read and implied
- Retrieve

Writing

This term we will write a conquering the monster story based on our reading text Beowulf. We will use our stories to create an information text.

As Scientists, we will learn that:

- Some substances will dissolve in a liquid to form a solution.
- The factors that affect the time taken to dissolve, including temperature and stirring.
- Some liquids and solids can be separated using sieving, filtering and evaporation and to describe these processes.

As Historians, we will be able to answer the following questions:

- Where did the Vikings come from?
- When did the Vikings invade Britain?
- What impact did the Viking invasion have on people living in Britain at the time?
- What was Danegeld?

As Geographers, we will be learning about life in the Alps, answering the following questions:

- Where are the Alps?
- What is it like in the Alps?
- Why do people visit the Alps?
- How is life in the Alps different to life in Hull?

In PSHE, we will focus on 'Being Me in my World', learning to:

- Compare my life with other people in my country.
- Explain why we have rules, rights and responsibilities to try and make the school and the wider community a fair place

As Artists, we will:

- Work with a range of media with control in different ways to achieve different effects, including experimenting with the techniques used by other artists.

In Music, we will focus on:

- Performing
- Listening
- Appreciating
- Composing and notation

In PE, we will learn fitness skills (indoor) and skills to apply to the game of Hockey (outdoor).

In Design Technology we will:

- Design and make a toy vehicle

In Computing, we will :
